NTG-EDSD Fair Use Statement

The NTG-Early Detection Screen for Dementia (NTG-EDSD) is intended as a tool for families, agency staff, clinicians, and researchers involved in supporting or assessing adults with intellectual and other cognitive disabilities who may be experiencing agerelated or neurological cognitive changes. Originally developed as an administrative screening instrument, the NTG-EDSD has since been adopted for broader purposes, including evaluating cognitive and functional status.

The NTG-EDSD is in the public domain for use, but it remains a copyrighted instrument held by the National Task Group (NTG). Use of the instrument is permitted under the following conditions:

- 1. **Attribution Requirement**: All uses must include proper attribution to the NTG and reference the NTG-EDSD as the source instrument.
- 2. **Modification Restrictions**: The content of the NTG-EDSD may not be altered or adapted in any manner, except for modifications to the demographic section. The inclusion of supplemental items or alternate wording is permitted only when such additions do not alter, replace, or misrepresent the original items of the instrument.
